Crossroads produces lighter weight travel trailers and fifth wheels towable by smaller, more fuel efficient SUVs and light trucks. This not only helps our customers conserve energy and save money, but it reduces air pollution caused by gas burning engines.

Our construction process is designed to reduce scrap to a minimum, and we recycle what's left such as paper, wood, steel, wire, and aluminum. Whenever possible, we use recycled materials. Our construction doesn't contain the toxic chemicals used in lamination and on average eliminates the need for 130 cubic feet of styrofoam per unit built.

Less than half of Crossroads employees drive a vehicle to work. Instead many choose to bicycle, walk, or carpool. Recycling, reducing energy, and preserving natural resources reduce our carbon foot print and helps to ensure that future generations will continue to enjoy America's beauty and the RV lifestyle. Recycling saves energy:

- **Creating a new aluminum can from scratch takes 95% more energy than making a can from recycled aluminum.**
